Well one of the biggest gambles of the season was landed last Saturday when Withhold landed the Cesarewitch for owner Tony Bloom, trainer Robert Charlton and Jockey Silvestre De Sousa. The horse was purchased over a year ago for £170,000 and then put away until making his seasonal debut at Kempton a few weeks ago for a get fit exercise and then got ready for the big day at Newmarket off an extremely competitive mark.

The coup landed not far short of half a million pounds for connections having been backed at massive prices anti-post. Tony Bloom who we all know is chairman of Brighton and Hove Albion is renowned as the Worlds most successful pro gambler of football betting and runs his operation from offices in London and Exeter where people can actually join one of his syndicates very much like a hedge fund if they have at least 50 grand to become a member.

I can tell you they win a good percentage of the time but still have losing runs from time to time however the long term profits are always achieved. Tony has a philosophy of if members leave his syndicates because of a losing run they are never invited back on the team. Anyway moving on this Saturday is Champions day at Ascot and what a feast we have in store with some of the best horses in Europe doing battle. I'm going to put up Caravaggio as Howie's Hottie in the 6 furlong group one contest at 2pm. The Aiden O'Brien colt takes on Harrys Angel again and although there isn't much between them over this track with its stiff finish and softer ground he might just come out on top.

FLAT

Boynton trainer C.Appleby - Pulled very hard yet still made the frame at Chelmsford. The run can be upgraded.

Syphax trainer K.Ryan - Finally starting to get his act together with a good run last time.

Forest Ranger trainer R.Fahey - Ran a shocker last week after running with the choke out. I'm sure we will see him run a lot better in the future.

Chelsea Lad trainer N.Meade - Seems to find 10 furlongs just to far and a drop back to the mile would suit.

JUMPS

Amour De Nuit trainer P.Nicholls - Just found out over 2 miles 4 furlongs could be slightly shorter might help.

Vision Des Fos trainer C.Tizzard - A very expensive purchase he made his hurdling debut at Chepstow running on to be 3rd. He is bound to come on for the experience.

BTTS At Stamford Bridge Tonight By Rick Elliott

Chelsea have one of the best goalkeepers in the world and a reliable defence but in recent matches clean sheets have been hard to come by and they have conceded at least one goal in four of their last five fixtures. Shutting out Roma in the Champions League this evening looks beyond them so the standout bet is both teams to score at Stamford Bridge. You can back that outcome at <u>21/20 with Ladbrokes</u>.

The home side should find the net and pick up one point at least. Chelsea have made a great start to their Champions League campaign with two wins and another victory tonight would put them in great shape to qualify for the knockout stages. Things are not going so well in the Premier League because Chelsea have lost their last two fixtures but an injury situation is improving and they can avoid defeat tonight.

Manchester United beat Benfica 4-1 in the final of the European Cup in 1968. They thus became the first English side to be champions of Europe and have since twice won today's equivalent, the Champions League. The teams meet in a group fixture in Portugal this evening and a DRAW (<u>11/4 with bet365</u>) is the most likely outcome. English clubs are becoming competitive in Europe again and the five sides in the Champions League could all come through this week's matches without defeat.

The richest race meeting in Britain and Ireland is the jumps fixture at Punchestown and the highlight is an intriguing conditions hurdle at 2.35pm. Campeador is the favourite but the price is too short for a horse that has fallen on his last two starts. On ratings there is little to choose between Campeador and THE GAME CHANGER but the latter has a rider's allowance of seven pounds. The horse is well treated over hurdles and looks a decent bet to win the race at <u>10/3 with William Hill</u>.

You can't keep a good man down and Sam Allardyce is the favourite to be the new manager of Leicester. He keeps threatening to retire but possibly feels there is unfinished business. Maybe he still resents being the only manager of England with a 100% win record which in theory should make him proud!
