Tipster Champions League

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Samcro Could Be The Star Of The Dublin Jumps Show

The Dublin Racing Festival is a new initiative that brings together some of the best jumps horses trained in Ireland and the culture of the capital. For some the headline acts will be Faugheen and Samcro but the others the stars of the show will be Damien Demsey and Stockton's Wing! The two main music acts after racing will have their support but hopefully most of the race goers will be at Leopardstown to bet on horses.

The inaugural festival replaces major meetings at this time of the year and features established races and others that are new to the calendar. Over the two-day weekend event there will be seven Grade 1 races including the Irish championships races for hurdlers and chasers. Potentially the best horse in action won't run in either because Samcro is still a novice who could run in any of three Grade 1s this weekend.

The timing of the Dublin festival is just right in the context of the Cheltenham equivalent which begins five weeks on Tuesday. There have been very few entries made by British trainers because they know they need a good one to beat the best Irish National Hunt horses in their own backyard. Several favourites for the races at Leopardstown over Saturday and Saturday are prominent in the betting for the championship contests at Cheltenham.

The meeting that matters most in March seems to be the be all and end all for British horses. In Ireland there is top class action over four days at Leopardstown at Christmas and the Punchestown Festival in the spring. That means Ireland stages three major jumps festivals over four months while Cheltenham and the Aintree Grand National meeting are shoehorned into a three or four week window. Easter falls on the first Saturday in April so there is a four week gap this year.

Samcro is the ante post favourite for the Ballymore Novices Hurdle at Cheltenham and second in the betting with some bookmakers for the Supreme Novices Hurdle. Its best to back the horse with bookmakers offering non-runner no bet for all 28 races at the Cheltenham Festival because stakes will be returned if the horse does not run. Samcro has been left in the Irish Champion Hurdle but will probably run in one of the novice events and the betting suggests it will be the novice hurdle on Saturday for which the horse is a worthy odds-on favourite which should be justified.

One of the intriguing aspects of the Irish Champion Hurdle is how Faugheen runs. The horse was pulled up at Leopardstown over Christmas and is probably drinking from the last chance saloon. There is a possibility that the horse will not show the form that was good enough to win the 2015 Champion Hurdle. Melon has seen the money this week and could start favourite. The horse was third in the International at Cheltenham and form with The New One and My Tent Or Yours in that race gives Melon a chance.

Our Duke is as short as 8/1 to win the Cheltenham Gold Cup. That price looks a steal based on the horse's scintillating win in the Irish Grand National last year. Our Duke has reached nothing like that level this season and the Irish Gold Cup could be make or break. In the absence of Sizing John Our Duke is the favourite for the race but there are too many risks involved in backing the horse. A more reliable proposition is Djakadam who has been in the shake-up in the last three Gold Cups.

If you back Melon and Djakadam and you lose money at least you can look forward to seeing Damien Demsey and Stockton's Wing race through some songs and on Sunday night there will only be 37 sleeps before the best National Hunt festival.

Today's Sports Betting Preview - By Rick Elliott

England Favourites To Be Champions League Winning Nation

More than half of all sports bets are placed on football and there are more members of FIFA than the United Nations. It's now just about a 12 month sport seemingly except for today when there appears to be no fixtures. The losers after this week's schedule in the Premier League are Arsenal, Chelsea, Manchester United and Marouane Fellaini. The Belgian international created Premier League history in United's 2-0 defeat away to Tottenham with the briefest appearance ever after coming on as a substitute. Fellaini didn't wait for an explanation from Jose Mourinho but stormed up the tunnel. He could have played his last game for UNITED who are now 1/2 to finish higher than Liverpool in the Premier League.

The race for the Champions League qualifying places took some strange turns this week. Arsenal lost to Swansea and Chelsea were humbled by Bournemouth at home and both London clubs conceded three goals. It's looking like any three from four teams getting into next season's Champions League because Arsenal are now six points behind Tottenham in fifth place. We are assuming champions-elect Manchester City are home and hosed which means United, Liverpool, Chelsea and Spurs are fighting over the scraps. One of the superpowers will not qualify for the Champions League through their league position but the waters are muddled if a Premier League team wins the competition this season. ENGLAND is the favourite and <u>11/8 with bet365</u> to be the winning nationality.

LE BOIZELO Looks A Decent Bet At 7/2

The racing fare is ordinary today with jumps meetings at Wincanton and Towcester and they race on the All-Weather at Southwell and Kempton. There is a handicap chase over two miles four furlongs at Wincanton (3.35pm) worth over £15,000 to the winner which makes it the richest race of the day. The first three in the betting are closely matched but on Racing Post Ratings Le Boizelo has a form edge and the horse is improving. The third favourite won over course and distance on heavy ground last month and has the scope to handle the weights hike. LE BOIZELO is in the hands of the 2015 and 2017 winning trainer so looks a decent bet at <u>7/2 with Ladbrokes</u>.

Today, we're going to look at spotting market moves and the best way to play them. We can't always get them right but in the long run, we should be able to turn enough low-risk trades into profit and make some good money.


Market Movers

The first thing to note is that we want to focus on the top of the market. The first horse, Heron, although heavily gambled on, is still not at the top of the market. We ignore this as sometimes we have something called false gambles and it could be a professional moving a price on a no-hoper so that the bookie pushes the price out on a favourite.

We also want to focus on Handicaps. The money that comes in these races is usually a lot more informed than, that of a Novice or a Maiden race.

Our first qualifier from the table above would be Shades Of Mist running in the 14:40 Southwell. We now need to head over to Oddschecker and look at the market.

We can see that the horse is within the top three of the betting. We now need to check to see if the horse is still one of the most backed horses.



Shades Of Mist is the second most backed horse and is worth backing as he'll most likely go off shorter than the current price.

Ladbrokes are going 6/1 about our horse and if you can grab some of this, all the better. Realistically, though we're probably more likely to get a bet down at around the 9/2 4/1 mark. This is still okay and we need to get the best price possible. If you can get BOG, then even better.

Once we've identified our horses and placed our bets, we now need to head over to Betfair to set up the second stage of our trade.

We're going to assume that Shades Of Mist will be going off a shorter price than the price we have taken. This is where we can lay off our original stake to secure a low risk/profitable trade.

Let's assume that the horse will go off at 3/1 (4 in decimals) and we have £10 staked. We now place £10 on the lay side at those reduced odds.

So, if the horse wins, we collect \pounds 60 from Ladbrokes but lose \pounds 30 on Betfair. Our trade has just bagged us \pounds 30. If the horse loses, then we lose the \pounds 10 from Ladbrokes but make \pounds 9.50 back on the exchange.

There will, of course, be times when our selections drift in the market and we still need to do the same thing. If the horse wins we will actually lose some money but if it doesn't we still get our stake back.

Have a go and make sure you paper trade first until you're comfortable with the strategy.
