Mullins Can Win His First 'Hennessy' With Total Recall

Not a lot of people may know this but the reason on Blue Peter sticky back plastic was used to stick things together when it was clearly sellotape is that Sellotape is a brand name and the BBC are not allowed to place products. When the name of a product becomes a word in its own right the company that sells the product have done something right. In horse racing some race titles become part of everyday language and the prime example is 'The Hennessy' aka the Ladbrokes Trophy.

The race's association with Hennessy ended last year with the 60th renewal which made the deal the longest running commercial sponsorship in British racing. Traditionalists might always refer to the race by its long-standing title but the truth is Hennessy ended the deal and Ladbrokes are now filling the breach. Racing cannot be too fussy with its partners and the Whitbread is now called the bet365 Gold Cup. Willie Mullins has never won the Hennessy but can win the race under its new name with Total Recall, a worthy favourite for the Newbury contest on Saturday.

The Ladbrokes Trophy is a handicap chase run over 3 miles and two and a half furlongs and there are 21 fences to be jumped. It's basically twice round Newbury and is one of the most significant and sought after staying chases of the season. In fact it is the biggest handicap chase after the Grand National and often a decent trial for the most famous jumps race in the world. Many Clouds is the only horse to have won both races and Bobs Worth was the last of eight horses to win the 'Hennessy' and Cheltenham Gold Cup. Native River won the race last year of 11 stone one.

Only three horses have won the race more than once, namely Mandarin, Arkle and Denman who all won it two times. Each of those horses also won the Cheltenham Gold Cup and Coneygree has a chance of emulating them by winning two of the major chases of the season but in different years. The leading jockey and trainer are associated with Mandarin. Nicky Henderson and Paul Nicholls have each trained three winners of the race and Barry Geraghty and Ruby Walsh are the only multiple winning jockeys this century. The last five winners have carried more than 11 stone.

The Hennessy is one of the few major National Hunt races that Mullins has not won. He was guarded about how much he believes his horse is well in at the weights but he doesn't bring horses to the mainland for the sea air and journey. Total Recall has a great chance of breaking Mullins' duck and could be a high class graded horse running in a handicap. At 10 stone eight the horse could prove to be a certainty and one of the standout bets of the season. The eight-year-old is relatively unexposed and has something to find on the ratings with several other horses.

Coneygree carries joint top weight with 11 stones 12 pounds and the 2015 Gold Cup winner could be competitive off that weight. Whisper carries four pounds extra due to a penalty which puts him on the same weight but pound for pound is not as good as

Coneygree. Braqueur d'Or sneaks in at the bottom of the weights and gives Nicholls a decent chance of a fourth win but Mullins trains the ace in the pack.

Total Recall had his first race for Mullins in the Munster National in October and the trainer was happy with how easily his horse won the race. However, Total Recall got an 18lb hike in the ratings for a seven-length win so he has a tough test of the new mark. Mullins feels there is some improvement to come so he runs the horse in the Ladbrokes Trophy. Handicaps are not an exact science but Total Recall is the horse to back in the race for some that will always be the Hennessy.

A Lifetime Of Achievement For Rooney - By Rick Elliott

It must be rare for both Merseyside clubs to have Premier League fixtures at 3pm on Saturday. Those bars around the area with dodgy satellite systems that apparently beam in live pictures illegally will be spoilt for choice. Both clubs play today on the back of outstanding results and the DOUBLE on Liverpool to win at Brighton and Everton to beat Huddersfield at home pays 15/8. Wayne Rooney is 9/2 with William Hill to score the first goal in the Everton match. He has been backed for the goal of the season after his brilliant effort against West Ham.

This year's Sports Personality of the Year is taking place in Rooney's home city. The show has a Lifetime Achievement Award and it would be fitting if that was given to Rooney in Liverpool. He left Manchester United to return home after breaking Sir Bobby Charlton's club goals scoring record and having achieved the same with England. Rooney deserves some recognition for those achievements but if he received the honour half the audience (the Reds) wouldn't know whether to laugh or cry.

Tiger Woods is five shots off the pace after the second round of the Hero World Challenge. His front nine in 31 shots was vintage Tiger and included three birdies and his first eagle in professional golf for some time. Woods might not win the event that raises money for his foundation but he is being competitive. If you think the dream can become a reality over the weekend you can back WOODS to win the Hero World Challenge at 14/1 with Ladbrokes.

The main feature in racing is the Ladbrokes Trophy at Newbury, or the Hennessy as it was known for 60 years. Willie Mullins has been cagey about what Total Recall could have in hand. He has a poor record in handicap chases in Britain but he did win the Grand National with Hedgehunter in 2005. Eight horses have won the Hennessy and Cheltenham Gold Cup and CONEYGREE could be the ninth and he is on offer to win today's race at 16/1 with Betfair.

Declan's Eye-Catchers - By Declan O'Donoghue

DALY TIGER (Noel Meade) Unlucky to meet a really hot one in Real Steel in a maiden hurdle at Thurles where they both cleared the last in a considerable hurry and they finished a mile clear of the rest. Must not be missed next time

GENERAL PRINCIPLE (Gordon Elliott) Better fancied than his winning stablemate Mala Beach in the Troytown Chase, yet while travelling well for a long way was never happy on the heavy ground. Sure to make amends on a better surface, there may be a temptation to put him away until the Spring Festivals, though Leopardstown at Christmas must be under consideration.

GRACEMOUNT (Sean Doyle) Gained a deserved and overdue success when stepping up in trip and well capable of following up at a similar distance and with some juice in the ground.

LIGHT THAT (Jessica Harrington) A decent sort on the flat and over hurdles, he could touch a higher level over fences judging by his initial effort when second to the highly impressive Bon Papa at Punchestown on Wednesday. Much better going right handed, he preferred nice ground on the flat. His trainer insists two miles is his trip and who are we to argue, though he wasn't short of stamina when racing "on the level."

RED DEVIL LADS (Emmett Mullins) Formerly with Rebecca Curtis, he showed plenty of his old zest with an all the way success in a Grade B handicap hurdle. Can mix it with fences and hurdles, so the Paddy Power Chase at Christmas could be a target. Needs soft ground though, not always a given at Leopardstown even in Winter.

REDHOTFILLYPEPPERS (Willie Mullins) Third in the hot Listed Mares Bumper at Navan with her owner David Dunson doing the steering. She's ready for hurdles now and stepping up in trip will help.

TYCOON PRINCE (Gordon Elliott) Promising start over fences when second to the very smart Al Boum Photo. While top class at one stage, he really lost his way over hurdles, but chasing was always going to be his game. Could have quite a future over the larger obstacles.
