Trainers In Good Form At The Moment - By High Roller Racing

Another three trainers have caught my eye this week and this pattern is proving popular as the highlighted trainers are producing winners most weeks from this article observation.

Jessica Harrington has her yard blossoming at the moment and came away from Dublin Racing Festival with two winners last weekend at Leopardstown including Supersundae in the Champion Hurdle. Things are quiet in Ireland this week but Jessica could have a couple of runners at Clonmel on Thursday with possibly Moonshine Bay being one. This horse seemingly needing three miles plus to show his best form. Jessica also has Fintara entered up on the same card at Clonmel. This daughter of Kayf Tara won a bumper at Punchestown and has had some placed form over hurdles. She is now to be sent chasing and this could see her develop following a Winter break.

Chris Gordon has his team in spectacular form and currently the yard is hot... and I mean very hot. In March 2017 they saddled 12 winners from 16 runners and although they are not at that level they are nearing it. Chris has had 'personal bests' from horses Jumping Jack, Tara Bridge, King Uther plus others so it's very prudent to look at Chris's entries and runners in the coming week or so. Chris has Ramore Hill entered both over hurdles and fences so it could be we look for the chosen engagement? Beware of this stables good form and do not get surprised when they keep winning. This is this stables best time of the year.

Our third trainer this week is Charlie Fellows who had his best ever year in 2017 saddling 29 winners and earring in excess of a quarter of a million pounds in prize money for the first time so it is somewhat surprising this is the first time I have included him in my articles. Although Charlie isn't turning out lots of winners at the moment there are signs that the winners are ready to happen very soon... keep your eyes peeled on entries and declarations. He has won with Spun Gold and Vice Marshall but near to hand Feathery a horse bought fairly cheaply from Jim Bolger catches my eye... has entries this week!

On a similar level Light Laughter bought from Dermot Weld could run a big race next time after a promising run at Lingfield.

Whatever you do look at the trainers I have highlighted and see if you can get their winners into your book. They are there waiting for us all but it's a case of waiting and spotting the good opportunities.

Five English Contenders For The Champions League

For the first time in the history of the competition one league accounts for five teams in the last 16 of the Champions League. English clubs from the Premier League are that quintet and ENGLAND are favourites at [11/8 with bet365](#) to be the winning nationality. A Premier League team have not been champions of Europe since 2012.

Teams from the old First Division dominated the European Cup in the late 1970's and early 1980's and there was another period of dominance in the mid to late noughties this century. However, this is the first season ever in which five Premier League outfits have qualified for the knockout stages of the Champions League. Tottenham (away to Juventus) and Manchester City (at Basel) are first in to bat tonight. The DRAW double is [15/1 with William Hill](#).

There is a direct correlation between wealth and wage bill and winning the Champions League. Basically the six richest clubs lift the trophy which means the two Manchester clubs are England's best hopes. Fans of Chelsea, Liverpool and Tottenham will be disappointed because their clubs don't have enough money to win the Champions League.

Manchester City have the backing of a nation and money literally is no object. Despite a huge global fan base Manchester United can't keep up and City will always have the resources to outspend them. Alexis Sanchez moving to United could be an exception to this rule. So MANCHESTER CITY are the tip to win the Champions League at [10/3 with Ladbrokes](#).

If the Champions League is the pinnacle of European football racing on the All-Weather at Southwell does not represent the best of British racing. However, beggars can't be choosers today because the jumps meetings at Ayr and Lingfield have been lost to the weather and Southwell is it if you want a bet on racing in Britain today.

The purpose of racing on artificial surfaces is to keep the show on the road when there are no turf fixtures. There is just £50,000 in prize money on offer over six races at Southwell but betting offices will have racing to show from this country. The Betway Handicap (3.25pm) is a Class 3 race worth less than £10,000 to the winner but is the most lucrative contest. COUER DE LION is the bet of the card at [7/4 with Coral](#).

Each Way Heaven - A Look At Today's Only Card - By Eddie Lloyd

There's only one meeting on today with two cards being subjected to abandonment. Never great to wake and find that there are only 6 races to analyse. However, Southwell isn't that bad a card and I've gone through all of the runners and looked for the horses I feel have the best chance of at least placing.

So, here's my take on the only card of the day –

2.20 – A 13 runner handicap is never going to be easy but I can't take the 15/8 about the favourite, Star Ascending. It's always worth opposing such short priced horses in a big field. My pick would be for the Richard Fahey trained Ingleby Spring. She was slightly outclassed last time out and drops back into a class 6. She's been eased in the weights by 3 lbs and the claimer on board has taken two very close of late. He'll be looking to go one better, here and Ingleby Spring is worth an each way tickle.

Ingleby Spring 13/2 Betfair

2.55 – Another ticky affair and we're 4/1 the field for this handicap. Caged Lightning looks to be the likeliest to go off the favourite. My preference is for Fran Berry's ride on Argante. He's got the stamina, having run well over hurdles and coming into a class 5 should see him up his game. He's had a bit of each way money for him in the offices and this is worth a go.

Argante 6/1 Hills

3.25 – The most competitive race of the day in terms of the prize money. Some of them might need to the run, here including the favourite Coeur De Lion. I'm going to oppose him at that price and go with the top weight, Mixboy. There will be a question mark about the standard going but he's got the stamina, Fanning takes the helm and knows him well so he's got to be worth an each way shout.

Mixboy 7/1 Betfair

4.00 – Another large field handicap and we're 5/1 the field. I've gone with another top weight in this one and the Carroll trained Mister Music. He ran well over this course and distance last time out. He's up 6 lbs but it's a quick turn around and he'll be

looking for the double. I'll side with him and there's still some value to be had for the place part of the bet at the current odds.

Mister Music 11/2 Corals

4.30 – Not a fan of these Novice races so will be keeping the powder dry!

No Bet

5.00 – It's definitely a day for the top weights in my analysis! I'll be siding with Dixon's Crosse Fire. He's not shown up of late but dropping into this class 6 and not a lot looking to threaten, I think today should be his day. He's short enough in the betting and there's money coming for him. On that basis, to end the day, I'm going to scrap the each way bet and go for the win only bet on him.

Crosse Fire 4/1 SkyBet
