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## All Roads Lead To Wembley From Manchester - By Ian Hudson

The teams in the last 16 of the FA Cup are just two matches away from Wembley. However, it's debatable whether the semi-finals should be played at the iconic national stadium. On the one hand you could say it devalues the final or the alternative view is that it gives more fans the opportunity to attend the last four fixtures and have their day out. The days of the semi-finals being played around the country are long gone.

Wembley occasions for Tottenham supporters are like London buses but more so. You wait for years to see your team play at Wembley and then 19 league matches and fixtures in the FA Cup and Champions League come along in the same season. If Tottenham do reach the semi-finals at Wembley will they be given the home dressing room? They can go one stop closer by beating Rochdale away from home.

The pitch at Wembley is always in pristine condition but the Rochdale turf is more akin to sand. Mauricio Pochettino is getting his excuses in early by suggesting the match should be moved if the pitch is not fit for purpose. That is a decision for the FA and match officials. It would be ironic if Tottenham draw at Juventus and lost at Rochdale five days later but that won't happen because even the Spurs reserves can beat the team who are bottom of League One.

Rochdale are the second lowest ranked team in the hierarchy who are playing in the fifth round. Ten of the survivors play in the Premier League. There are only three top tier meetings so in theory seven of the eight quarter-finalists could come from the top division. Despite the romance of the Cup and David and Goliath encounters one of the superpowers runs around Wembley with the Cup in May. Since the start of the Premier League era the average position of the Cup winners is 4th.

Coventry City won the FA Cup in the 1986-87 season and are the only representatives from the fourth tier this time. They have drawn a Premier League team away from home but a match at Brighton won't have a major effect on finances. The rewards from playing Manchester United at Old Trafford in front of a crowd of about 78,000 dwarf the money they will receive if 15,000 people turn up at Brighton. Premier League class should tell and Brighton can qualify for the last eight.

Three of the eight fifth round ties start at the traditional 3pm kick off time and two matches have been rearranged for Friday night. Leicester and Chelsea look home bankers against Sheffield United and Hull. Leicester have the best chance of the teams outside the top financial bracket of winning the Cup. The squad is not greatly changed from the title-winning group. Leicester are not playing in Europe and are safe in the league so can focus on the FA Cup. The players know how to win a trophy.

Swansea look the most vulnerable of the Premier League outfits and are odds-against to beat Sheffield United on the road but a draw and replay is on the cards. The West Brom and Southampton meeting is difficult to call but the two Manchester giants have winnable away matches. A City and United final is the favourite in the 'Name The Finalists' market and nothing should happen this weekend to change that outcome. The clubs have never met in an FA Cup Final but that could happen at Wembley this May as long as Tottenham don't spoil the party for their guests.

#### **Europa League Huge For Arsenal Now**

Manchester United set the precedent last season by qualifying for the Champions League by winning the Europa League. The minor European competition could be Arsenal's best route into the one that matters most because they are falling off the pace in the league. Needs must and Arsenal are in need and Arsene Wenger wants to keep his job and he's an intelligent man.

Jose Mourinho worked out that United had a better chance of getting into the Champions League from winning the Europa League than finishing in the top four. Wenger may have come to the same conclusion so ARSENAL should be fully focused when they play at Ostersund tonight in the last 32 of the Europa League. The Premier League team are <u>9/2 with Ladbrokes</u> to win the trophy.

There are some big outfits in the Europa League this season, including Atletico Madrid who have played in two of the last four Champions League finals and Napoli who are league leaders in Italy. Arsenal must not be losing to Ostersund this evening if they want to compete with these clubs. They are now sixth in the Premier League and eight points adrift of Chelsea in fourth place. With 11 fixtures remaining Wenger may now see the importance of the Europa League just like Mourinho did last season.

It will be cold when Arsenal take on Ostersund in Sweden tonight and the atmosphere could get very chilly if they continue the run of not conceding in one of their last 12 matches. However, there is a significant gap in class and Arsenal must concentrate on the Europa League because of their position in the Premier League. In any case the DRAW is the standout bet against Ostersund at 3/1 with William Hill.

I hope you will be all staying up until 3.56 in the morning to watch the women's cross snowboarding final but if you must retire early you could have a few quid in your pocket after a winning horse racing bet. Kelso is the most lucrative meeting today and the Morebattle Hurdle (2.25 is the richest race on the card. In snowboarding speed is important and contenders BETTER GETALONG. The horse with that name should be backed to win the Kelso feature at 2/1 with bet365.

### The Each Way Strategy - By Eddie Lloyd

Betting each way is a great way to make our money go further when investing on the horses. If we know what we're doing we can find value selections that have an extremely high strike rate when placing our bets, that gives us either most of our stake back, break even or even a big profit.

Finding value selections in betting is a topic that is talked about a lot between professionals and novices alike. It's not always about finding the winner of a race but more about finding a horse that has been overlooked in the market by the bookmaker and in the long term we can profit from these discrepancies if we know what we're looking for.

I have put together one of the best ways to find this value and how best to use it.

This method can be used at any time on the day of racing but your results will be even more accurate if you can do the analysis within 30 minutes before the off.

So let's get stuck in and look at how we can profit from value each way betting.

#### **System Rules**

Below you will find the 2 simple steps to finding the qualifying races each day.

- 1 We only use handicap races
- 2 We look for odds-on favourites

Once we have looked at these 2 simple rules we will have a list of potential races that will show us qualifying horses.

Today's races are 3:45 Fontwell and the 6:30 Chelmsford.

We simply back the second favourite in these races. If you can find two races like this on a daily basis, then we put them into an each way double. Of course, they won't always come in but even if they place, we'll make a small profit from our each way bet. If they both win, then we make a tidy profit.

These are the qualifying horses, for today -

### 3:45 Fontwell – Tactical Manoeuvre 6:30 Chelmsford – Thahab Ifraj

Staking a 1 point each way double for a 2 point bet would make us 3 point profit if they both place, which is what the market is suggesting and if they both win, then we

will see a whopping 45 points profit. This type of gain is what makes these bets worthwhile doing and will pay dividends in the long run.

Have a play around and make sure you paper trade initially but in the long run, these bets work out really well.
