Russia Outsiders In Their World Cup

The World Cup hosts should have a genuine chance of winning the tournament and RUSSIA are 50/1 with <u>Ladbrokes</u> to become the world champions in 2018. Purely on football matters it seemed a strange choice and as the World Cup approaches Russia are the second lowest ranked team of the 32 qualifiers. The hosts have lost their last three matches and were beaten 1-0 in their last fixture by Austria who have not qualified for this year's tournament. A World Cup in which the hosts are eliminated early lacks something and Russia will struggle to get out of the group.

Russia have very little chance of emulating France who are the last nation to win the World Cup in their own country, in 1998. England famously won the World Cup at home in 1966 and Germany were world champions in their own back yard in 1974. Argentina won their own tournament in 1978. Holland were losing finalists in both 1974 and 1978 but they are absent this time. Russia should avoid defeat against Turkey tonight and the DRAW is the best bet at 9/4 with <u>Betfair</u>.

England restored some pride at Test level by beating Pakistan to draw the short series one match each. They are a much better outfit in white ball cricket in which matches are played over a limited number of overs. This form of the game packs out grounds but is debatable whether Old Trafford will be full on this Tuesday even though Yorkshire are in town to play Lancashire in the One-Day Cup. The incentive is all with the visitors because Lancashire can't qualify for the knockout stages. The White Rose side can still qualify for the semi-finals but need to beat their closest rivals today and a win for YORKSHIRE is 4/6 with William Hill.

There are five meetings in Britain and Ireland today and the prize money is derisory. No race in the UK is worth a five figure sum while in two weeks there is a huge amount of money on offer at Royal Ascot. Racing is healthy at the festival end but the numbers don't add up for owners at the bread and butter level. The handicap chase at Kilbeggan (8.25pm) is the richest race of the day and JUSTMEMYSELFANDI has the form and ratings to prevail and that outcome is 10/1 with **bet365**.

Three Rather Hot Trainers To Follow - By High Roller Racing

Several trainers are attracting my eye at the moment but none as much as the very 'hot' looking trainers included in my article this week. These are two trainers in excellent form and one 'under my radar' about to explode... I hope!

Mark Johnston always seems to be churning out winners week after week, month after month but he keeps getting them over the line in first position. He is currently operating at 17 per cent of the runners are winning which is terrific for a large yard with so very many runners. Over 60 per cent of Marks horses are actually running to and above their form... another impressive statistic. We cannot ignore this guy who is a trainer to be reckoned with. Looking at the entries for this yard Burgonet immediately caught my attention for Sandown. Addicted To You and On A May Day also looked in need of consideration. So ignore Mark Johnson at your own peril.

Tom Lacey I have brought to my articles a few times but he is doing so well I bring him to your attention again. After a rather frustrating run of seconds Tom was a relieved guy to see Sword Of Fate win a match at Southwell. When you get seconditis you start doubting and thinking there is a problem when really there isn't. Tom has Sword Of Fate entered up again at Southwell on Tuesday and he could go in again. Silk Run and David John are expected to go well for the yard is their selected entries this coming week... the latter needing to be kept away from soft ground I feel. So look out for Toms runners too.

Sir Michael Stoute has had, by his standards, a slow start to the season... I am hoping the winners are about to flow and reach explosion limits in the coming week or so. The horses Gabr and Braemar both produced career best efforts and Beachwalk showed the benefit of running with a run under his belt when winning at Lingfield... he seems a long way ahead of his handicap mark. It won't be long before Royal Ascot and I have been told Sir Michael fancies Poets Word and Crystal Queen to go very well at the meeting. Although the yard isn't as powerful as it was in days gone by the trainer is certainly able to get a horse ready for the big races. Let's not ignore the Stoute team.

Tuesday's Horses In Focus - By Unity Racing Investments

This week we saw a really nice 16/1 winner in ALLBARNONE which was a huge gamble on the day setting off at 7/1. Another winner yesterday with MUSIKA at 3/1 winning easily. That win is quite significant to us as we are undergoing a period of change we have been working on several new strategies for the company.

Over the last year we have been successful with our big priced bets however this has hampered our strike rate. We have been looking at ways of increasing this, so we have a regular supply of profits and what we have found is really quite special. What this means for Unity Clients is hopefully a sustained period of profits with smaller losing runs we are positive that it will have a positive impact on our results long term without large draw downs. You should see smaller prices. A much higher strike rate and fewer bets.

The first horse from this selection was an easy winner and we have 4 today on the account. I shall share two of them here as we try to keep prices intact for members.

Newcastle 6-45 Handicap (Class 6) 12f - RAVENSWOOD was having his first race since leaving Patrick Charmings when finishing 2nd at Musselburgh that was much improved form. By all accounts the horse has come on from that run and goes off the same mark here. 5/2 looks short on paper but I can only see one horse to fear and that is 6/1 shot and one for the rev forecast SANAM.

Newcastle 8-45 Handicap (Class 5) 5f - BLAZED is a consistent performer and likes the surface 11/4 in places that can be considered a bit of value we make the horse a 6/4 chance of winning. This horse has also recently moved stables and looks very progressive. I think there is plenty of wins in him and his mark will continue to rise into the 90s this year according to my source. I wouldn't put you off having an each way double as I think both horses represent great chances. We have 2 more similar bets on the main service so join today to get full access to these bets and all the rest we will make. It is exciting times for Unity.
