Tottenham Could Be On The Way To Wembley

I think the EFL Cup is in fact the old League Cup but I'm not entirely sure. Whatever the competition is it must be the most pointless trophy in English football. The final is played at Wembley but the big boys only get interested around the quarter-finals stage. The early rounds clog up the schedules and there are 22 meaningless ties tonight. However, the cream usually rises to the top and in the last five years the winners have been Manchester City (3 times), Manchester United and Chelsea. TOTTENHAM can build on World Cup success for many of their players to take a step forward and win the trophy and that outcome is 8/1 with Ladbrokes.

The televised EFL Cup fixture is AFC Wimbledon's home meeting with West Ham who have lost their first three matches in the Premier League. Team selection is important but not critical because West Ham have the squad to beat the League One side with some of their fringe players starting the match. The Premier League outfit are managed by Manuel Pellegrini who won the trophy twice in three seasons at Manchester City. With league points a priority he may not start with the first 11 but he has respected the competition in the past. WEST HAM have the strength in depth to beat Wimbledon in 90 minutes and you can back that result at 7/10 with Coral.

The US Open is the fourth and final Grand Slam tennis championship of the season and is played in New York. Matches sometimes go on late into the night and the atmosphere gets raucous. You can back Novak Djokovic at 1/50 to beat Marton Fucsovis or American FRANCES TIAFOE to beat Adrian Mannarino in the evening match on the Grandstand court at 8/15 with **bet365**. The fans should be well refreshed by the start of the match and there could be some loud partisan support.

The racing is ordinary today with very little to get excited about but there is a trappy handicap over six furlongs at Epsom (3.15). The form horse and favourite is Desert Frost who has been placed in five races this season without winning one. The horse might not like passing other runners and the herd instinct could be holding him back when it matters most. HIGHLAND ACLAIM is a course and distance winner and is the horse to back at 4/1 with **Betfair**.

Don't Miss These Three Red Hot Trainers - By High Roller Racing

Nigel Tinkler, Gordon Elliot and William Haggas are three trainers in very good form and must be followed in the coming week or so. When these guys hit form they do so with vengeance.

Nigel Tinker is enjoying his best spell for some years and we need to watch his horses. Daffy Jane has won three of her last five races and could go in again this week as she has several entries. She has progressed with each run and connections tell me they are looking to get Silvestre De Souza to ride wherever she goes. It's worth noting Silvestre has won on Daffy Jane the last twice he has ridden her. Bashiba a good horse for the yard last season and will warrant respect if running at Musselburgh on Wednesday off 1lb lower... the horse ran well last week finishing second after being involved in scrimmaging... a winner without a penalty in my mind. Archie Perkins looks one to lookout for at Carlisle as he looks thrown in. Whatever Nigel Tinkler runs at the moment warrants respect.

William Haggas is in very good form at this time as I write. His team are in fabulous form especially his middle distance horses. Jurran is a very interesting animal who has several entries this coming week after finishing second at Redcar recently where he was caught near the line... he is one to look out for especially if he heads North to run. Other interesting horses from the yard include Field Gun, Croque Monsieur and Nomoathaj between them having several entries so we need to watch carefully where they are entered AND actually where they run. William knows how to place horses.

Gordon Elliot is one of the leading trainers in Ireland and is better known for his National Hunt horses but he does sent some runners out on the Flat. So far the yard has had 41 winners this season in UK and Ireland as Gordon sources races for certain horses in the North of England usually Perth or Carlisle but Sedgefield, Hexham and other northern tracks need to lookout for Gordon's runners in the coming weeks as he continues his search for winners. He actually sent two over to Saratoga in USA recently. This man is not frightened of any opposition. Ignore Gordon's entries and you could be making a very big mistake. Study his entries as he may have six or seven horses entered in one race then look at which one he actually runs. You must also back those he runs in the north of UK especially with Richard Johnson onboard. Gordon likes quality horses but he also likes quality riders.
