## Today's Sports Betting Preview - By Rick Elliott

#### Manchester United Can Beat Juventus

When Manchester United played Valencia in the Champions League at Old Trafford earlier this month the club had to invite fans to attend because the match did not sell out. There was a ballot to distribute the few remaining tickets for tonight's home match against Juventus because it was oversubscribed. The only way you can get into the stadium tonight is by buying a ticket off a tout because it's such a huge game. United have lost just one of their last 22 home matches in European competition.

Juventus have won all their away matches this season and they have a certain Cristiano Ronaldo playing up front. The heart is probably ruling the head but if MANCHESTER UNITED play like they did for the last 20 minutes against Newcastle and most of the away match at Chelsea they are the bet at 23/10 with **Betfair**. It's a tough match for United which they can win as outsiders against the champions of Italy for the last seven seasons.

Manchester City are away at Shakhtar Donetsk and after losing at home to Lyon on match day 1 cannot afford another defeat. Shakhtar have conceded at least one goal in their last six fixtures in Europe at home and keeping a clean sheet looks beyond them against City. However, an English side has never beaten the Ukrainians at home who have lost just once in 15 European fixtures at their own ground.

City are not playing in the Premier League until next Monday night so all this nonsense about the demands of playing in two competitions within a few days does not apply. Five different players scored against Burnley on Saturday and Kevin Be Bruin returned to action. Pep Guardiola can select his strongest side and his team need a result so won't be sitting back. However, Manchester City look too short to win but they can avoid defeat so the DRAW is the bet at 5/1 with **bet365**.

There is an All-Weather Fast Track Qualifier for two-year-olds over six furlongs at Newcastle today (3.40). It's a Class 2 race worth over £16,000 to the winner. Two-thirds of juvenile races are won by horses that finished in the first three on their last start and there are four qualifiers. SWISSTERIOUS finished down the field in a valuable sales race at Redcar 17 days ago but is the nap at 15/8 with Ladbrokes.

# **Terms And Tack Used In Thoroughbred Horse Racing** -

Hi Everyone hope your having a good run with you BetFan Service. Not sure how many of you understand some of the tack used by some of our Trainers and Jockeys. I thought it might be of interest for those not knowing to briefly check matters out. After all some of the tack used has to be declared or it will not be able to be used. I have had horses running where the trainer forgot to declare a visor so we were not allowed to put it on the horse for the race.

Every racehorse wears a Bridle... this is leather made headpiece that holds the bit in place to steer and guide the horse where the jockey would like it to go.

Some horses wear cheekpieces, sometimes known as French Blinkers these are used to encourage the horse to look forwards and not look sideways.

Normal blinkers are also used to encourage a horse to look forwards and not be put off by horses ranging alongside. Blinkers can encourage a horse in a tight finish to a race.

Visors are another piece of headgear that is sometimes used to assist the horse in looking forwards but the visor allows a little more side vision than blinkers.

So horses get disturbed entering the stalls. A double blanketed cover that fits behind the saddle and covers the hips for stalls entry and horse doesn't get knocks entering the stalls. It helps sometimes nervy horses. There is a ring and short rope near back of rug to allow it to fall off easily when horse leaves the stalls. This blanket is normally known as a Monty Roberts Rug/Blanket.

Hoods are also used on horses to allow them to concentrate and reduces noise levels that upset some horses. Aidan O'Brien is using visors and hoods more nowadays.

Tongue ties are sometimes worn to prevent a horse from getting their tongue over the top of the metal bit which would create steering problems for the jockey.

I do hope the information is of interest and you can see in declarations the abbreviations for things like horse wearing visor, tongue tie, blinkers etc.

When making selections the tack being worn should be considered as most have to be declared. Even now horses have breathing operations need to be stated.

Newcastle 3-10 Handicap (Class 2) 6f - GLENAMOY LAD is a horse you should have in your notebook we mentioned him a few weeks ago and backed him only for the ground to go against and he never took his chance. He's ready to win and has been gambled the last twice when entered. He didn't run either time but connections are on today.
