Prospects For The Rest Of The Season

Wolves are looking comfortable in the Premier League and are in pole position to finish 7th. There is a gap of 11 points to the place above so Wolves cannot break into the top six at least this season. They have had some reverses against teams from the bottom half of the table but have done well is some matches against the top six. Beating Manchester United in the FA Cup looks beyond them but Wolves

can win enough games before the end of the season to confirm 7th place. That process can begin with their next fixture away to Huddersfield.

England Can Beat The Handicap Against Wales

Wales and England are not the best of friends but when thy meet on the rugby field the rivalry becomes more intense. They clash today in a potential Six Nations decider at the Principality Stadium in Cardiff. Both teams have won their opening two fixtures so the title is on the line today. England's form is the stronger and they can win beat Wales for the fifth meeting in succession. Scoring records suggest they should be about 10 points' favourites so the bet is ENGLAND -4 at Evens with **Paddy Power**.

Tottenham are at Burnley today in the Premier League. They have won their last 16 league matches against teams outside the top eight and are on a run of four wins. That recent form has been achieved without Harry Kane and Dele Alli. Burnley are unbeaten in 2019 with four wins and three draws. However, they have won just two points in their last 14 home matches against the top six. The balance of form means TOTTENHAM are the bet at 4/6 with **bet365**.

Leicester the home team and Crystal Palace are becalmed in mid-table safety, free from relegation worries and unlikely to qualify for Europe. They meet today in the Premier League when Roy Hodgson will become the oldest manager in Premier League history. The visitors are in the quarter-finals of the FA Cup while Leicester have lost five and drawn one of their last six matches. PALACE are a decent outfit on the road so can oblige today at 5/2 with **Paddy Power**

Kempton stages two novice hurdle races that could be significant pointers for Cheltenham. However, the richest race on the card is the Class 1 handicap chase over three miles at 3.35. Some of the runners appear in ante post betting for similar races at the Festival but today's prize is worth winning. LAURINA obviously added huge spice to the Punchestown meeting on Wednesday, and the Champion Hurdle hopeful proved a tidy and efficient winner.

Smart stablemate Stormy Ireland - now 6/1 for the Mares Hurdle - made sure that the 30/100 favourite got nothing easy, though she still moved through the gears effortlessly for Ruby Walsh when required.

Ruby is not always the easiest to please but he was very happy this time.

"It felt like a race today whereas Sandown was just a canter around."

"They went a good gallop and she did it really well" Ruby explained.

"She made one mistake when she was perhaps a bit too relaxed."

"She needed that run and it should leave her spot on" he added.

Laurina is now six from six since joining Mullins, and while Apple's Jade has looked visually a lot more impressive - and in much harder races - there's no denying Laurina is a class act who really could be anything.

Mullins might just have pulled a Mares Novice Hurdle rabbit out of the hat with Allez Dance who justified 2/1 favouritism in the opener under Paul Townend.

"She'll get an entry, she has had her problems and I didn't think she'd win quite like that" Mullins said.

Noel Meade and jockey Sean Flanagan are on a roll and completed a fine double when Cap York - 13/2 from "tens" - and The Caddy Rose 100/30 both obliged.

Mark O'Hare booted him home and Meade said: "We have been struggling with our bumper horses because we have not been able to get them out on grass."
